Sir/Madam,

It is brought to the notice of the Board that the extremely severe floods have affected thousands of lives of animals and human beings which are facing a threat of losing their lives and unpredictable destruction of property in the State of Assam. Thus, the severe flood is going to inflict very heavy damage on vast tracts of land, animal shelters, livestock etc in Assam.

2. It is therefore, understood that there is an urgent need to help the suffering and affected animals in the areas affected by floods, by providing medicines, food, shelter and water to the affected animals. Hence, it is requested to provide emergency relief to the distressed animals.

3. The Board also requests the AWOs/SPCAs to voluntarily do relief work and provide emergency relief to the distressed animals. With your support we hope to provide assistance to the distressed animals in this hour of crisis.
