The Animal Welfare Board of India is an autonomous body established by the Government of India under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1960 (Central Act). The Board is at present, under the Control of Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, New Delhi, Government of India.

Under Section 38 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1960, the Central Government has made the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Application of Fines) Rules, 1978. A copy of the same is enclosed for ready reference.

These rules are enforceable in all States and Union Territories. We request you to kindly implement these rules under your State/District. As per these Rules the amount realised as fine amounts under the PCA Act should be made over to the Animal Welfare Board of India by DD or Cheque drawn in favour of "Animal Welfare Board of India" payable at Chennai.)

We shall be grateful if you can kindly implement and enforce these Rules and send the remittance of fine amounts realised under the PCA Act 1960 to the AWBI as required so as to enable us to take further necessary action.
