The Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) is a statutory body established under Section 4 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960. The functions of the Board include the promotion of animal welfare generally and for the purpose of protecting animals from being subjected to unnecessary pain or suffering, in particular.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C) No.440 of 2000, Geetha Seshmani Versus Union of India & Others dated 6.8.2008 and in W.P(C) No.881 of 2014, Gauri Maulekhi Vs Union of India & Ors dated 13.7.2015 has directed all the State Governments to make the State Animal Welfare Board functional at the State level and District Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCAs) at District level to address animal cruelty matters, to promote animal welfare programmes at the grass root level and to assist AWBI in implementation of the provisions of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and the rules made there-under.

In this regard, it is requested to ensure that State Animal Welfare Boards are made functional so that the provisions of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and its Rules are implemented effectively to prevent unnecessary pain or suffering to animals.
