

PUBLIC NOTICE

It has come to the notice of the Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) that certain individuals and groups are circulating fraudulent appointment letters, authorization letters, email and postal communications falsely claiming to have been issued by the AWBI. Such documents have been reported particularly from the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, Andhra Pradesh and in other regions cannot be ruled out.

All concerned are cautioned not to act upon or respond to such communications, not to share personal information and not to make any payments or comply with any instructions contained therein. Any person receiving such suspicious letters, emails or communications is advised to report the matter immediately to the nearest police station.

For verification of any communication purportedly issued by the Animal Welfare Board of India, Individuals may contact the AWBI only through the official contact details provided on the website of AWBI i.e. support@awbi.gov.in.

The AWBI wishes to inform the citizens/individuals that appointment letters or authorization are issued by the AWBI in such a manner as all vacancies are properly advertised and published in the public domain and appointment letters are sent through official email- ID of the Board and through registered post / speed post only.

This notice is issued in the interest of public awareness and to prevent misuse of the name and authority of the Animal Welfare Board of India.

It is further stated that the office of Animal Welfare Board of India shall not be responsible for any untoward situation arising out of such communications.
